Bringing together students from diverse cultural and academic backgrounds, the programme combines literary analysis with social and cultural inquiry to promote empathy, critical thinking, and intercultural dialogue.</p> <p>Looking into non-literary texts from the media as well, the programme will help improve students' comparative skills and media literacy skills.</p>
