APPLICATION AND REGISTRATION PROCESS

Candidates should upload the following documents on http://www.ktu.edu.tr/oidb between the dates 10-19 July 2023. Candidates will be informed by e-mail (e-mail account they registered with) during the evaluation process in case of any missing/inaccurate documents. So, candidates are supposed to check their e-mails frequently and update their applications in case of receiving any e-mail about missing/inaccurate documents during the application process. Applications of candidates who do not complete the required changes about the documents will not be evaluated. Also, in case of submitting any false document/information intentionally during the application process, candidates will be deregistered from the University, regardless of the levels of their education, and legal proceedings will be initiated against these individuals. Before applying, candidates are recommended to check https://www.ktu.edu.tr/oidben/internationalstudents to see the registration calendar, last year's information about the departments and their placement scores to guide them during their application process.

A. Documents to Upload

- 1. Exam Result, (KTU-YOS and TR-YOS will not be uploaded)
- 2. Certified Copy of High School Diploma (approved by the high school directorate in the Turkish or English languages),
- 3. Student certificate and transcript for candidates who have not graduated (approved by the high school directorate in the Turkish or English languages),
- 4. A copy of Passport or ID,
- 5. A document (certified and sealed passport or security records) showing that the students had been in the country where the diploma was obtained during their high school education or that they entered and exited the country, (for those who are Turkish citizens and graduates from high schools abroad that provide formal education; dual-citizens (one of which is Turkish)),
- 6. Certificate of identity register copy for those who ceased to be Turkish citizens or have a blue card.
- *1. Certificate of Equivalency will not be requested from the candidates during the preference application, but the registered candidates are supposed to submit their equivalence documents within 3 months at the latest.
- *2. The photos that the candidates will upload to the system should be biometrically taken in 4,5x6 size within the last six months, since they will be used in all official transactions such as student cards, etc.

B. Evaluation and Placement Criteria

- 1. Applications will be taken online on 10-19 July 2023. Candidates who are placed in a department will be announced on http://www.ktu.edu.tr/oidb, on 21 July. Candidates who have the right to register will not be notified individually.
- 2. In the placement, candidates with KTUYOS and TR-YOS exam results will be given priority. Then, the YOS exams of other universities, international exams and high school diploma scores are evaluated for the placement.
- 3. In case of equality in the placement scores, the high school diploma score is taken into consideration first. Then, the order of preferences is considered. In case of equality in all circumstances, younger candidates are placed.
- 4. For candidates of the same nationality to be placed in a department, there is a nationality quota limit of 20%. In case of additional placements, the nationality limit may not be applied.
- 5. For those who are Turkish citizens or dual-citizens (one of which is Turkish) who graduated from high schools abroad, and who ceased to be Turkish citizens with blue cards, there is a nationality quota limit of 10% for the Faculties of Medicine, Pharmacy and Dentistry.
- 6. Following the first placement, additional placements will be made for the vacant quotas by the decision of the University. Candidates placed in the first application cannot apply for additional placement.
- 7. Candidates with a success lower than 60% of the total score in their high school diploma will not be evaluated.

Exam scores accepted by the Senate for application are defined in the table below. There is no validity limitation for the exams which are accepted as equal to high school graduation certificates (Abitur, International Baccalaureate, GCE, Tawjihi etc.). For the exams which are accepted as university entrance exams (SAT, TR-YOS, etc.), there is a two-year validity.
